**All skill levels welcome.** Digital SLR, mirrorless, or advanced point & shoot are recommended.

**What To Bring:** Camera, camera manual, lenses ranging from 16mm to 200mm -- whatever lense(s) you have work(s), memory cards, extra camera battery. Optional: a tripod, speedlight, reflector, filters.
